Principal's Message continued:

If you are unable to pick a child up from school, please contact the out of school care facility on 67693485.

Out of School Care-Maria has had a few children use this service but nowhere near as many as indicated would use it. If the service is not supported, it will not be sustainable and we will lose a very valuable service.

Parents who are entitled to rebates do not have to pay full fees. As long as your CRN (Centrelink Reference Number) is supplied, the rebate is applied to the bill and you are only billed the appropriate amount. If you are entitled to a 60% rebate, this reduces the cost to only \$2.80 per hour for the service-very cheap child care. I would ask as many of you as possible to support the facility. It took a great deal of work to get it in place and would be a real loss to the community if it was to fold.

On Sunday 24th November 2013 the Tamworth Regional Conservatorium Youth Orchestra will be performing in Nundle. Students who learn musical instruments have the chance to play with the orchestra and take part in workshops throughout the day. I would encourage you to get your child involved in this opportunity and come along and listen to the afternoon concert. There will also be a number of performances by the conservatorium music teachers.

Presentation night will be Wednesday 11.12.2013 at 7.30pm in the Nundle Hall.
