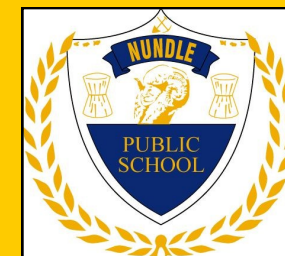

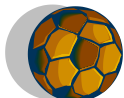
Soccer Sign Up

We are short of second hand winter uniforms for girls, sports uniforms etc.

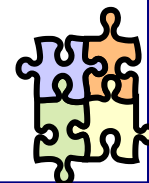
