time I get scared

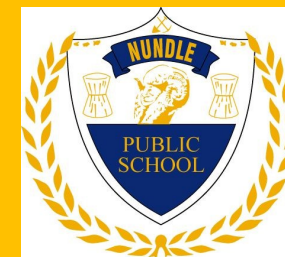

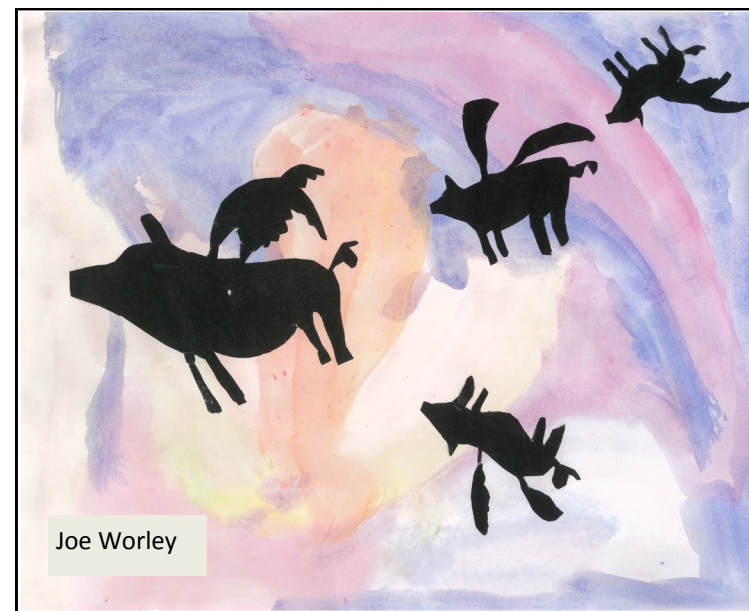
