

Year 2 Classroom Highlights Mr McDonald

Term 1 has been full of fun and learning for our Year 2 students! Each day during teacher reading, we've been diving into some exciting "big kid" books. Right now, we're enjoying the adventures in James and the Giant Peach by Roald Dahl.

In writing, we've been exploring prepositions and how they add detail and meaning to our sentences. One great example the class came up with is: "The dog chased the ball under the fence." It's been exciting to see how our writing is growing!

During our reading sessions, we've been focusing on fluency and expression. This week, we had lots of laughs reading a story about two toads getting married.

In maths, we've been investigating efficient ways to count large collections of objects. We've also explored how big numbers are made up of smaller ones. For example, we discovered that there are many ways to make 12, like 5 + 5 + 2 or 2 + 3 + 7.

Every Tuesday, we're joined by our Kindergarten and Year 1 friends for art lessons. This term's theme has been birds, and we've had fun creating colourful owls, moonlit owls, vibrant feathers, and even some very funny ducks!
